Dear parent.

This book is written for young children, between 3-5 years of age, who are having difficulty using the toilet for poos. This might be because of:

- an experience of constipation and painful defaecation
- a change in the child's life such as the birth of a brother/sister or
- a fanciful or fearful idea the child has imagined.

It is recommended that you read the story to your child and watch how they respond. Let the story work subtlely: avoid overexplaining or telling your child what you want them to do.

This book should not be used in isolation. It is important to seek your doctor's advice. Your child might need investigation and treatment. You might also see an occupational therapist or psychologist to help manage the problem.


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Plopsy was a poo. Plopsy lived with lots of other poos inside the body.




At the end of all the slippery slides was the ROUND DOOR.




Everybody asked: "WHY won't you jump Plopsy?"

Grandpa Poo told Plopsy that one day HE did not want to open the ROUND DOOR either.


He was SCARED he would get stuck. He was WORRIED it would hurt. He didn't even know how to swim!






and he said:

(water),



Jumping in, is so...... (COOL)"


GUESS WHAT HAPPENED?

PLOP!!!!!!!!!




Plopsy was in the BIG POOL. There were lots of poo friends to play with and Mother Poo had a great, big smile on her

Plopsy thought very carefully about what the wish should be.




Finally...Plopsy said "Can I jump into the BIG POOL EVERY DAY because I think I like it now!! Mother Poo said 'Yes'.




